Dear Congregation,

Today (June 15, one day after U.S. Flag Day) Sandy Davis, Marty Cook, Steven Moser (Coast 2 Coast director for this site), and I led a flag changing ceremony at our Lee Road veterans memorial flagpole. A tattered and worn Old Glory was replaced by a new one donated to the church by Coast 2 Coast. My role was to narrate what each of 13 foldings meant as Sandy and Marty lovingly folded the flag. I also led the Pledge of Allegiance for everyone present including over 100 children and camp counselors. (Prior to this event, once again I led a summer “chapel” lesson, this time on Daniel and his loyalty to God.)

Although we did not use it today, I've always liked the text of “The American’s Creed”, written in 1917 by William Tyler Page. It was accepted by the United States House of Representatives on April 3, 1918. The creed represents to me the heart of what this nation stands for:

I believe in the United States of America as a government of the people, by the people, for the people; whose just powers are derived from the consent of the governed, a democracy in a republic, a sovereign Nation of many sovereign States; a perfect union, one and inseparable; established upon those principles of freedom, equality, justice, and humanity for which American patriots sacrificed their lives and fortunes.

I therefore believe it is my duty to my country to love it, to support its Constitution, to obey its laws, to respect its flag, and to defend it against all enemies.

May we all practice “true patriotism” to preserve our democratic republic. The principles of “freedom, equality, justice, and humanity” need everyone to do his or her part in order to maintain.
