November 2023 Financials

Financial performance for November was excellent, the second consecutive month of significant positive cash flow. For the second consecutive month, low Trustee expenses of only \$4,081 combined with Total Revenue of \$27,966 resulted in positive cash flow of \$4,136 for the month. Total Revenue for 2023 is projected to finish 2% above forecast while Total Expenses are projected to finish 3% below forecast. Available cash on hand (BBLD) to pay operating expenses grew to \$171,648. For the year, we have paid 100% of budgeted Apportionments of \$28,506. There were 70 "Givers" for November vs a 2023 monthly average of 66 household giving units. Respectfully submitted.


