#### UPDATES FROM PASTOR RUSTY FOR LEE ROAD UMC PEOPLE

DATES: The next Tyger River Long Weekend ("TR #34") is almost here! The 4-day "walk" at Tyger River is October 30-November 2, 2025 (Thursday through Sunday); however, Rusty will not attend the last day on Sunday, November 2 as that is All Saints Sunday and we will be having a confirmation service for our 3 awesome confirmands!

UPDATE: SCDC is not allowing us to bring in meals as in the past. The prison Warden is allowing to us to bring in snacks, breakfast muffins, cookies (see below), and 1 MEAL on Saturday, Nov. 1. (Please don't ask me to explain b/c I can't. I am just the messenger.) So, if you would like to donate money to Kairos, write check to Lee Road UMC and put Kairos on the comment line. The money will go to support the Kairos Ministry in the Upstate, perhaps Tyger River, or 1 of the 17 SC prisons Kairos chapters that need help. This is to spread the Gospel and Christ's love for these men. I believe that this is a worthy cause.

COOKIES: If your Sunday School class (or you as an individual) would like to bake a few dozen cookies for Kairos, please contact Sandy Davis, our cookie coordinator. He knows the approved recipes, how to bag them and freeze them, the collection date to bring them to church, etc.

After combined Consecration Sunday in the Sanctuary (starting @ 12:15 PM)


